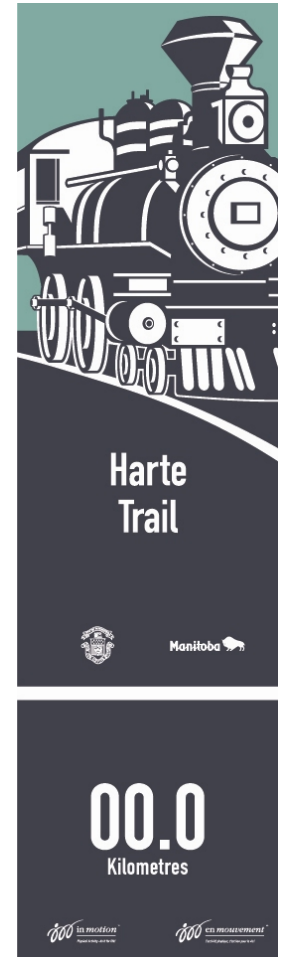
# Winnipeg Trails Association

# External Funding for City of Winnipeg

- \$ 1.6 Million
  - Harte Trail extension
  - Bishop Grandin Greenway West extension
- \$ 500,000+ asphalt + gravel
- \$100,000 Trail Wayfinding Signage project
- \$ 8,000 Kilometer marker project
- \$ 85,000 +++ Trail head project
- \$ 5,000 Detailed trail maps

# Preliminary 2009 Capital Budget

**“Environmental sustainability is a City priority.”**

- **\$95 Million for streets and bridges in 2009**
- \$1.75 Million for Active Transportation

# \$1M Trail Development

- **Retain \$1.6 M in external funding**
  - Complete the Bishop Grandin West extension
- **North Winnipeg Parkway (Trans Canada Trail)**
- **Trail head funding**
  - Ensure seed funding to leverage additional
- **Improve Connectivity on existing routes**
  - Safer intersections
