Bike to the Future strongly supports this rezoning, particularly items 1.A.vi to 1.A.xii (7 items), because riverbank access along this property is a major missing link in the North Winnipeg Parkway, which is an important component of Winnipeg's Active Transportation Network, and also provides "active and green" recreational opportunities for the community.

Bike to the Future is a voluntary, inclusive group of concerned citizens working to make cycling in Winnipeg a safe, enjoyable, accessible, and convenient transportation choice year-round.
