\$80 - \$100 Million is being spent

over the next few years to rehabilitate the Perimeter and Hwy 59 interchange



Currently NO PLAN for SAFE cycling infrastructure

is being included in the \$80 - \$100 Million rehabilitation. Rather than removing barriers, this project adds barriers for cyclists and pedestrians to improve levels of service for motorists.

Yet a few hundred meters west of the new intersection

pedestrians and cyclists traveling the Northeast Pioneers Greenway are risking lives to cross the Perimeter to access the town of Birds Hill, Birds Hill Provincial Park and the new Red River Floodway Trails system.

A SEPARATE PEDESTRIAN / CYCLIST BRIDGE over the PERIMETER is required for SAFE CONNECTIVITY

PLEASE CALL a PROVINCIAL REPRESENTATIVE (contacts on flip side) and ask them to connect the Northeast Pioneers Greenway SAFELY over the Perimeter Hwy to Birds Hill Provincial Park and the Red River Floodway Trails System. Call them this summer – before the Provincial election on October 4th.
